Last gasp goal

Today's English for football is a last gasp winner or last gasp equalizer. Now last gasp in football means at the last moment, in the last minute, so for example, the 90th minute or in extra time. A last gasp winner is a goal scored in the 90th minute or extra time. For example John O'Shea's goal against Liverpool was a last gasp winner beating the Reds one-nil at Anfield. A last gasp equaliser: for example, Messi scored a last gasp equaliser for Barcelona against real Madrid. His goal meant that Barcelona drew with real Madrid 3-3 in the 90th minute.
